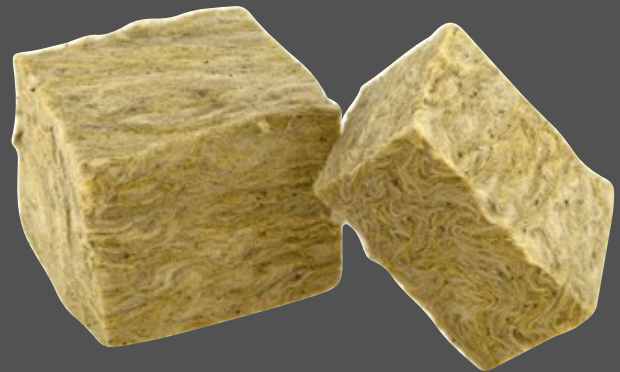

Rockwool is a type of insulator material made of rocks, mainly basalt, with a fixed chemical composition. It is melted at high temperatures and bonded with specific additives using advanced techniques. The final product is cut into strips and can be sold as rolls.
